As part of our recent move to Portwall Lane we launched our own exhibition space: The Beachcroft Space. This is a large window display area fronting the Brunel Mile, a busy walkway which links the great engineer's railway station, Temple Meads with his ocean liner, the SS Great Britain.

The Beachcroft Space is somewhere local artists can display their work, providing a creative focal point for visiting clients, the firm's employees and passers by. The exhibitions will change quarterly. Any artist with a connection to the South West of England is welcome to apply to the exhibition selection panel which is made up of Beachcroft partners/employees.



The current exhibition is due to finish on Monday 8 February 2010 and we are now inviting submissions for the next exhibition. The exhibition space is approximately 16 metres long by 1 metre deep and is 2.8 metres from floor to ceiling. Unfortunately, due to the constraints caused by the exhibition space's proximity to a working area, we are unable to consider installations which move, make any noise or require electricity.

Submissions must be received by 22 January and should include a brief biography, photographs of the artist's work and a brief explanation of the context and aims of the artist. Artists are welcome to send submissions at any time and we will review them on a rolling basis. After the January deadline our next exhibition deadlines will be on: 31 March 2010, 30 June 2010 and 30 September 2010. Please note that this is not a commercial space from which artists may sell their work. However, we are happy for the artist to include contact information including gallery and agent details in the display plaques.
